## Little Caesars Pizza Kits

## Student Privacy

## Ontario Student Nutrition Program

The OSNP program is designed to supplement the nutrition that students bring from home. For HRPS, this means that a 'snack bin' is provided to each class as the school day starts. This includes foods such as yogurt/yogurt tubes, fruit, cheese strings, whole grain cereals and cereal bars or cracker packages. Students can select a snack if they would like something additionally than what their lunch provides. We are going to be able to offer more options due to additional funding we have recently received. Our first offering is going to be after March Break, 8 oz. bowls of mac & cheese, which will be served to all students in the school spread out over three dates. These dates are included on the calendar.
